- 12 events, 7 cuts made, \$100,946 (78)
- Recorded two T15s at the Wegmans LPGA Championship and the Jamie Farr Toledo Classic
- Third on Tour in putting average (28.58)

Career Highlights

- Played pain free in 2012 following several wrist surgeries
- Begins the 2013 season at 24th on the LPGA Career Money List with more than \$6.5 million in earnings
- Crossed the \$1 million mark in season earnings four consecutive years from 2005-08
- Became a Rolex First-Time Winner at the 2005 Weetabix Women's British Open, a major championship; the same year she also led the Tour in birdies and carded a career-low 62 at the Longs Drugs Challenge
- Finished T37 at the 1999 LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament to earn Tour status
- At one time was the top-ranked amateur in South Korea, winning the 1997 Korea Women's Open and the 1998 Korea Women's Amateur

- Works with Operation Smile, a charity that provides free reconstructive surgery to children around the globe suffering with facial deformities
